# PREPAREDNESS (pre disaster)

**CODs** 

Admin boundaries - Population Statistics - Other CODs - Cleaned/ checked/endorsed and on HDX

**RAPID** 

Understand who will do the DIM and how. Is the data available?

3W lite

Identify key agencies in country who are likely to respond. Encourage key individuals to sign up on HID.

Have a list of clusters and cluster lead agencies.

# **DAY ONE** (Initial steps)

**Disaster Impact Model** 

How many people likely to need assistance by: Age/sex - Location - Severity Deconflict with others i.e. WFP

**Contacts** 

Set up HID and get people to sign up. Have a simple list with cluster coordinators.

**Basic Infographic** 

Showing whatever information is available, (collate info from DIM/Flash Appeal).



**CODs**

Staffing / strategy

Requesting surge support through Regional Office, ERR, FIS, etc. Speak to HoO, your Regional IMO and FIS.

IMO-A: HCT, Staffing, HID (Coordinator/Generalist). IMO-B: DIM, Infographic, CODs (Mapper/Visualizer/Generalist)

# AY THREE (Kick-start operations)

#### IM Working Group (IMWG)

COD/HDX - endorse.

HID - sign up.

3W - agree on plan w/ timeline.

IM capacity - who is coming?

OP guidelines – clusters manage cluster data,

OCHA manages inter-cluster data.

TOR - Do we need one? Agree to set up Dropbox and Skype group

### Maps for Sitreps

Ensure a unique map, highlighting content in the sitrep is produced using the template.

#### **Humanitarian Snapshot** Use information from DIM.

Sat images

Liaise with OCHA HQ and UNOSAT to coordinate requests and needs.

Act as focal point for remote sensing requests and dissemination of products.
