

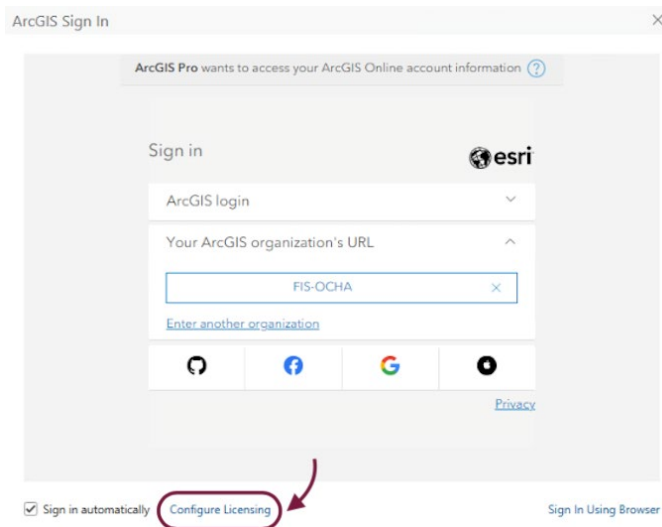
Please follow these instructions to complete your software authorization:

Step1- Save the attached license file to your machine.

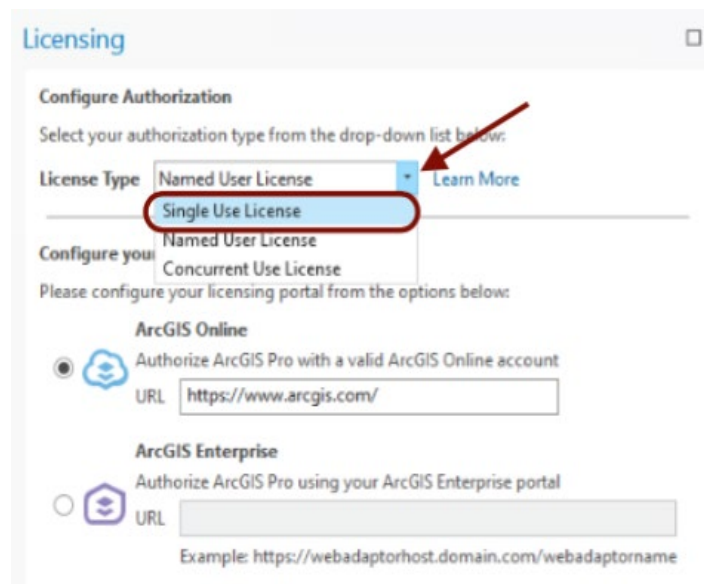
- The file should have .prvc extension for example:
(ArcGISPro_SingleUse_1378.prvc)

Step2- Open the ArcGIS Pro application. And follow step by step installation below:

1- Click on **Configure Licensing do not sign into your account.**



2- Select **Single Use License from the License Type → click **OK**.**



3- Select the **License level** (Advanced, Standard, Basic) based on your request.

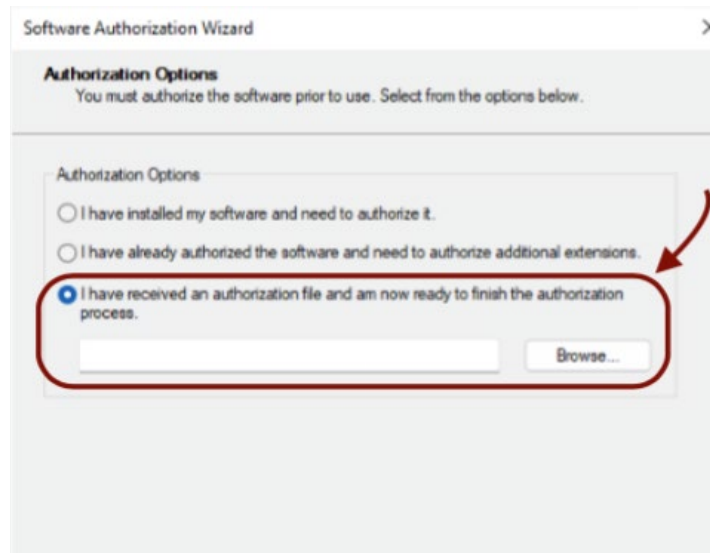

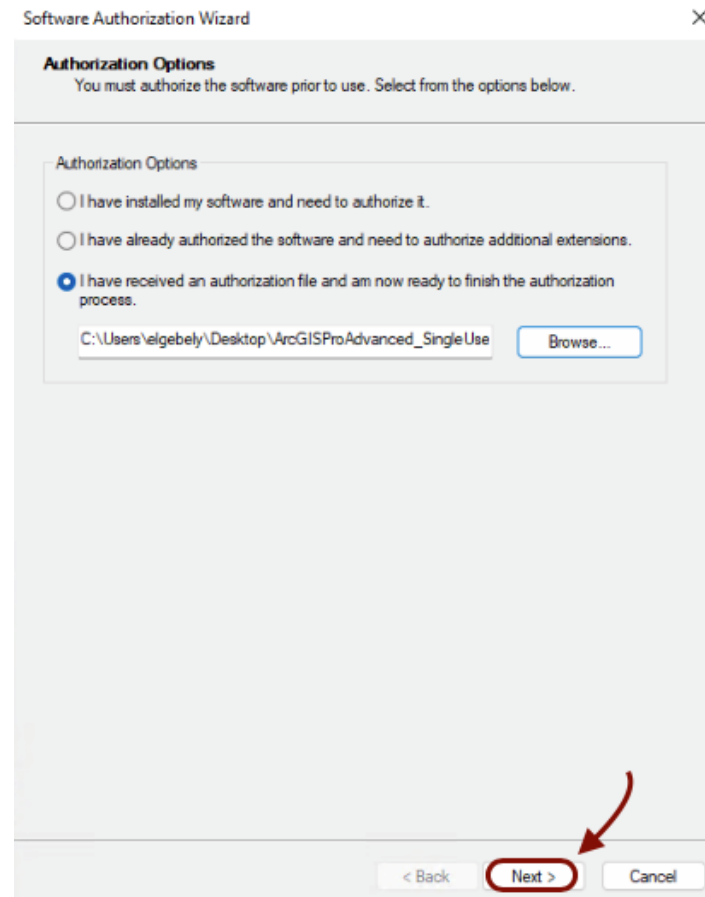


- 5- From the Authorization Wizard from Select the option "I have received an authorization file from Esri and am now ready to finish the authorization process."


