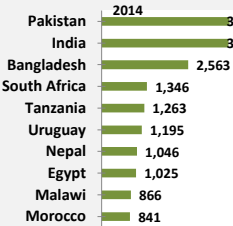

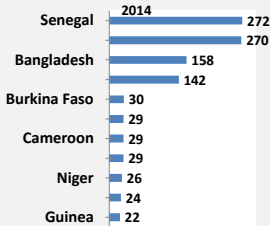

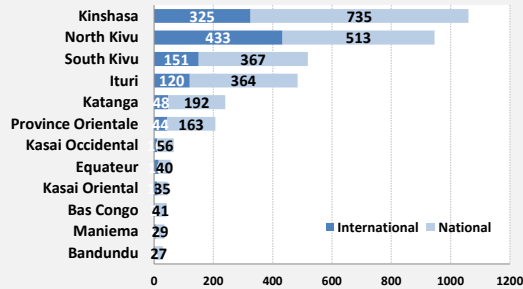
Top TCCs as of 31 August

MONUSCO Civilians staffs per duty stations as of 7 Sept. 2014

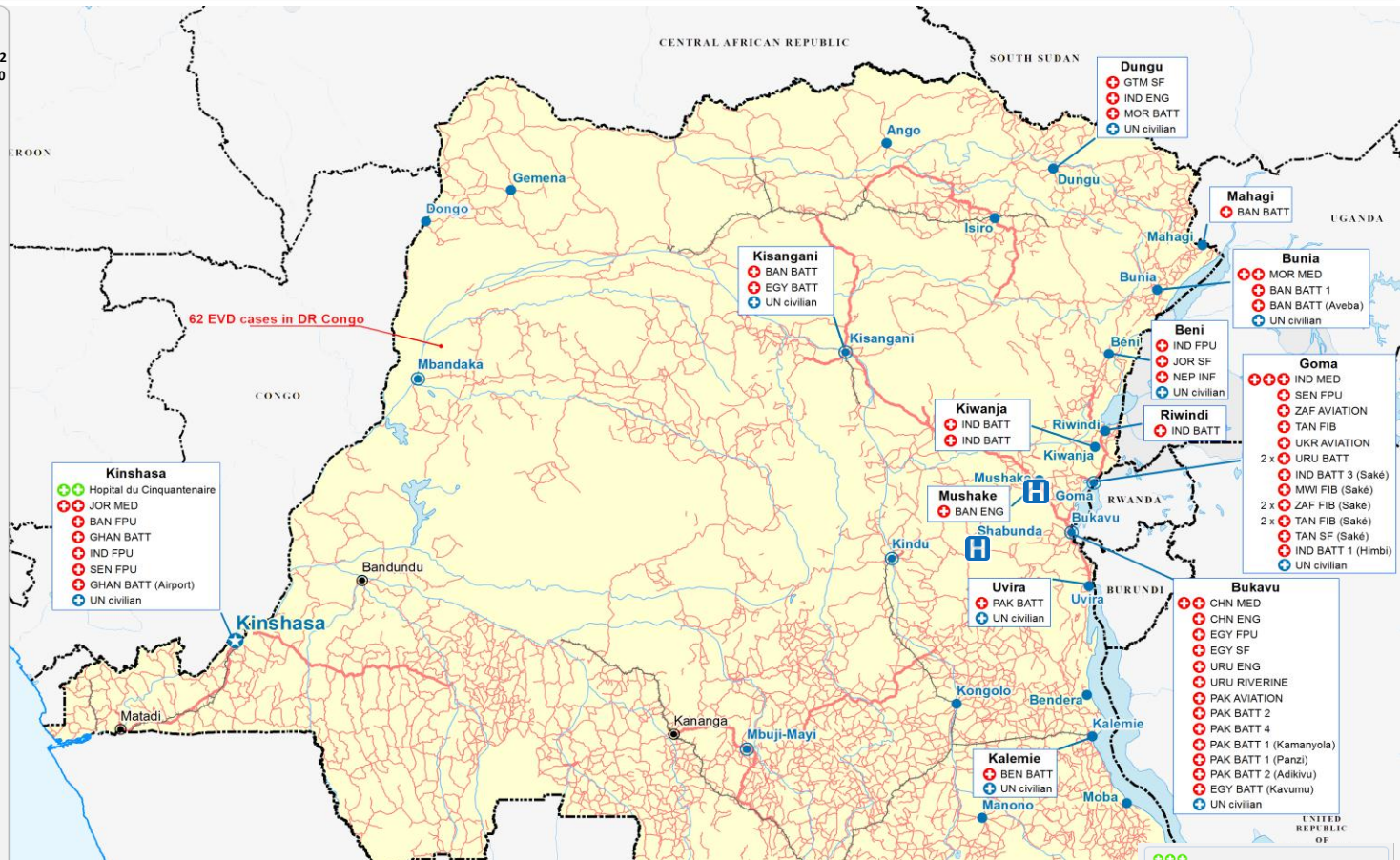
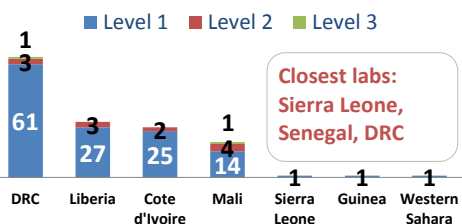

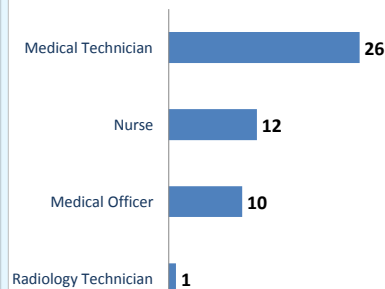
