Humanitarian Response (www.humanitarianresponse.info) is a specialised digital service of the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA). Since its launch in 2012, its purpose has been to support efficient, effective, and coordinated humanitarian response by providing an online space where emergency responders can collaborate on, share and find operational information.



Structure

HR.info is like a Russian doll, with web-spaces nested one inside the other. The wider level is what we call the global HR.info, then there are operations, clusters and sub-clusters within operations. Each operation and cluster is self-managed by IMO's in the field.

Operation Features

Go to the Operations page (www.humanitarianresponse.info/operations) to find the operation of your interest. In the operation space you will see a set of features. The number of features available in each operation may change, as these are at the discretion of the operations/clusters managers. Below the full list:

Searching content

Whenever you want to find content on HR.info, consider its structure and do the search within the webspace that is most meaningful.

For example go to the Nigeria site if you want information related to the Nigeria operation, then search. But if what you are looking for is from the WASH cluster in Nigeria, then start your search within the Nigeria WASH cluster.

Use the “Search” box at the top of each page and then narrow the results using the filters on the left side. Or start from the content type you need by clicking on the related tab (Contacts, Events, Documents etc) and then use the filters.
